Presentation of Revised Constitution

Elliot Shackelford:

- Article III: General Membership Rules
 - Terms of Service (3 years instead of 2 years)
 - Code of Conduct (used to be in the Bylaws)
 - Attendance and Responsibilities (2 unexcused absences instead of 2 unexcused absences in a row/5 absences overall are grounds for impeachment)
- Article IV: Elections, Appointments, succession and Impeachment
 - Elections, Appointments, and Succession (more details concerning succession)
 - Impeachment (person to be impeached has the right to submit a rebuttal report; $\frac{3}{4}$ of quorum required)
- Article V: Officer Roles (8 officers instead of all officers can be elected, everyone else will be appointed)
 - Student Body President
 - Vice President of Policy
 - Vice President of Finance
 - Vice President of Communications
 - Vice President of Student Events (instead of "Student Life")
 - University Senator
 - Senior Class President
 - Senior Class Vice President
- Article VI: Meetings
 - Council Meetings (more vague)
 - Committees (new Class Officer Committee)

- Article VII: Executive Board
 - Eboard
 - Budget (President and VP of Finance have more authority)
- Article VIII: Supremacy of the Constitution (4/5 instead of 2/3 necessary to change the constitution)
